

Rental Agreement & Applicable Fee Schedule

Effective for Lake Country Bins moving-bin rentals

Customer Agreement. By placing an order, accepting delivery, or checking the agreement box at checkout, the customer agrees to the rental terms and applicable charges below. All reusable bins, lids, dollies, and other rented equipment remain the property of Lake Country Bins.

1. Standard Rental Period

Each moving-bin package includes a 14-day rental beginning on the scheduled delivery date. The customer is responsible for having all rented bins and equipment empty, reasonably clean, and accessible for pickup on the scheduled pickup date.

2. Delivery and Pickup

Lake Country Bins will deliver and collect rented equipment at the address provided by the customer. The customer is responsible for providing safe and reasonable access for delivery and pickup and for communicating relevant gate, driveway, building, parking, or placement instructions.

3. Care and Permitted Use

Bins and rented equipment must be used for ordinary moving and storage purposes. The customer may not use the equipment to store or transport hazardous, illegal, corrosive, flammable, excessively heavy, or otherwise unsafe materials. Normal scuffs, scratches, and reasonable wear from ordinary moving use are expected and will not result in a damage charge.

4. Rental Extensions

Customers needing additional time should contact Lake Country Bins before the scheduled pickup. Approved extensions are subject to inventory availability and are charged at \$49 for each additional 7-day period. An extension is not confirmed until approved by Lake Country Bins.

5. Missing, Unreturned, or Damaged Bins and Lids

The customer is responsible for rented equipment while it is in the customer's possession. A charge may apply when a bin or lid is missing, unreturned, or damaged beyond normal wear. Damage includes conditions that make an item unsafe, unusable, or unsuitable for future rental.

6. Rented Dollies and Other Reusable Equipment

Any dolly or other reusable accessory provided as a rental must be returned with the bins. If rented equipment is lost, stolen, not returned, or damaged beyond normal wear, the customer may be charged the reasonable repair or replacement cost, not to exceed the replacement value of the item.

7. Additional Pickup Trips

Bins and rented equipment must be ready and accessible at the scheduled pickup. If Lake Country Bins cannot complete pickup because the equipment is not empty, not accessible, or otherwise not ready, and another trip is required, a \$39 additional pickup charge may apply.

8. Additional Charges and Payment

When an applicable extension, loss, damage, replacement, or additional pickup charge occurs, Lake Country Bins may issue the customer an invoice describing the charge. The customer agrees to pay valid additional charges by the due date stated on the invoice. This agreement does not, by itself, state that Lake Country Bins will automatically charge a customer's payment card after checkout.

9. Inspection and Documentation

Lake Country Bins may inspect rented equipment at delivery and pickup and may document missing or damaged equipment when reasonably necessary to support an additional charge.

10. Customer Responsibility

The customer is responsible for safeguarding rented equipment from loss, theft, misuse, and avoidable damage during the rental period. The customer should promptly notify Lake Country Bins of lost, stolen, or materially damaged equipment.

Missing or unreturned bin	\$15 per bin
Missing or damaged lid	\$5 per lid
Bin damaged beyond normal wear	Up to \$15 per bin
Additional / failed pickup trip	\$39 per additional trip
Lost or damaged rented dolly or reusable equipment	Reasonable repair or replacement cost, up to replacement value
